


In line with our Home School Agreement, we would welcome your support by:-

Dear Parents,


This booklet provides you with some general information on the subjects that will be covered by your child this term.

This term, our work in **Literacy** will start with a narrative focus on folktales, focusing on vivid descriptions and story structure. For our non-fiction work we will be looking at biographies and autobiographies. We will be following the National Curriculum for Literacy, using the Literacy and Language programme.

In **Numeracy**, we will continue to use place value to order numbers and partition, recognise and continue number patterns and confidently use the four operations. We will also continue to focus on securing our knowledge of times tables. We will develop our understanding of fractions and decimals, also time and money.

In **Science**, children will be learning about sound and electricity.

Our **History** topic for the term will be 'Invaders and Settlers', during which we will be learning about the life of the Vikings in Britain. Throughout this topic, pupils will be developing a range of historical, Art and Design and Technology skills.

We are focusing on 'Jeux et chansons' (Games and songs) in **French**, 'Going for goals' and 'Good to be me' in **SEAL** and 'Saints and Heroes' in **RE**. Within **ICT** we will be looking at sending and receiving emails, with a further emphasis placed on e-safety. We will then move on to studying control, using bee-bots. We will be learning how to play stringed instruments in **Music** which will continue to take place on Tuesdays.

In **PE**, we will cover Invasion Games and Net and Wall games. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week. Swimming details will be sent as a separate letter.
