

This booklet provides you with some general information on the subjects that will be covered by your child this term.


We have also included examples of ways in which you could further support your child's learning at home. We provide homework on a weekly basis and also conduct a spelling test each Thursday.

This term, our work in **Literacy** will focus on Historical narrative, newspaper reports, stories from other cultures and persuasive writing. We will continue to learn the year 3 and 4 spellings using the Read, Write Inc scheme.

In **Numeracy**, we will be consolidating our work on place value, addition and subtraction methods, multiplication and division, fractions, shape, space and measures.

In **Science**, we will be looking at the topic 'Where does all that food go?' This will focus on healthy eating, teeth and digestion in humans and animals.

Our **Geography** topic will focus on our town 'Beverley'. We will be reading, drawing and following maps. We will learn about the history of our town, and use maps to follow the town trail. During **Art**, we will study the local artist Fred Elwell. We will find out about his life, and produce some of our own art work in his style.

We are focusing on 'Relationships' and 'Changes' in **SEAL**, and 'Creation' in **RE**. This unit looks creation stories from different religions. In **computing**, we will be learning about the different opportunities the internet offers for communication such as emails, Skype and blogging. We will also be using digital tools to explore different locations on Google Maps.

In **PE**, our external coaches from Tigers Trust will visit the school. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week.
