


In line with our Home School Agreement, we would welcome your support by:-

This booklet provides you with some general information on the subjects that will be covered by your child this term.


We have also included examples of ways in which you could further support your child's learning at home. We provide homework on a weekly basis.

This term, during our work in Literacy we will be using the Literacy and Language program covering a range of fiction and nonfiction texts. We will also be reading and studying books by different authors. There will continue to be a larger emphasis placed on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In **Numeracy**, we will be ensuring we can use place value to order numbers and partition, recognise and continue number patterns and confidently use the four operations. We will also be focusing on securing our knowledge of times tables.

In **Science** we will be studying 'food' and 'our bodies'. This will include finding out about healthy and balanced diets, describing parts of the skeletal system and looking at joints, bones and muscles.

Our **History** topic for the first half term will be 'Ancient Egypt', during which we will be learning about the life and beliefs of the ancient Egyptian people. Throughout this topic, pupils will be developing a range of historical, Art and Design and Technology skills. In the second half term we will be learning about the Tudors.

We are focusing on **French**, Jigsaw PSHE, and 'Remembering' in **RE**. Within **ICT** we will be looking at internet safety. We will be learning using Charanga in **Music**.

In **PE**, we will be covering Multi-skills and then Dance.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week. Swimming details will be sent as a separate letter.
