


In line with our Home School Agreement, we would welcome your support by:-

This booklet provides you with some general information on the subjects that will be covered this term.


We have also included examples of ways in which you could further support your child's learning at home. We provide homework on a weekly basis which will be set on a Thursday.

This term, during our work in **Literacy**, we will be using the Literacy and Language program, covering a range of fiction and nonfiction texts. We will also be reading and studying books by different authors. There will continue to be more emphasis placed on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In **Numeracy**, we will be focusing on the four operations, measure and fractions. We will also be focusing on securing our knowledge of times tables.

In **Science** we will be studying forces and magnets.

Our **Geography** topic for the first half term will be 'Tales of the Riverbank', looking at how rivers flow and change. During this topic we will be painting in the style of Monet. During the second half term, our topic will be 'From Farm to Fork', looking at how food gets from farms to our tables.

In **French**, we will be learning: verbs to express opinion (J'aime, n'aime pas, adore, déteste); animals and family members; adjectives such as colours, petit, grand and the possessive adjective for 'my' (mon, ma, mes). **PSHE** will be taught through our Jigsaw scheme of work. In **RE**, we will be studying the unit 'Faith Founders'. Within **ICT**, we will be focusing on research and presentation skills. We will be learning about **Music** through our scheme of work called Charanga.

In **PE**, our external coaches from Tiger's Trust will cover a range of topics. The children will be taking part in some outdoor adventure activities. We will also be doing gymnastics during the Spring term. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week.
