
- ✓ Talking to your child about the work they have done in school.


This booklet provides you with some general information on the subjects that will be covered by your child this term.

This term, our work in **English** will focus on our Literacy and Language topics called 'Stories with Flashbacks', 'Biographies' and 'Explanations'. As always, we will be having a huge push on handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar. Reading throughout the Key stage is a huge focus and we are encouraging the children to read for at least 20 minutes a night.

In **Maths**, we will be developing knowledge of multiplication and division. We will also be exploring algebra, area/perimeter, ratio/proportion, as well as completing some mathematical challenges to put our skills to the test.

In **Science** we will be studying materials, both sorting them and looking at how materials can change. This is a hands-on topic with lots of investigations.

Our **History** topic this half-term sees us focussing on the history of leisure and entertainment. We will look at how technology has developed over the years to bring us to where we are today.

In **Jigsaw** (PSHCE) we will be focussing on relationships and changes. We will continue our Growth Mindset development and study 'Changes and New Beginnings' in **RE**. Within **Computing** this term, we will be looking at film-making linked to what the future will hold.

We will be focussing on **Wellbeing** throughout the term which will focus on looking forward. This will tie in nicely to our transition work and making sure that our Year 6 pupils are ready for the move to secondary school.

In **PE**, we will be developing our cricket, tennis and athletics skills. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child comes to school in their PE kit on **Thursdays and Fridays** this term.
