  efforts and encouraging them to try their best.



This term, during our work in **Literacy**, we will be using the Literacy and Language program, covering a range of fiction and nonfiction texts. We will also be reading and studying books by different authors. There will continue to be more emphasis placed on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In **Numeracy**, we will study the objectives from the Year 4 National Curriculum, including; place value, the four operations and perimeter. We will also be focusing on securing our knowledge of times tables.

In **Science** we will be studying 'The power of forces' and 'Changing states'.

Our **Topic** for the first half term is 'Healthy Hearts and Minds'. We will focus on influences and personal choices. During the second half term we will study the Mayans in our theme 'Wonderful World'.

In **French**, we will be learning; greetings, animals, names of body parts, colours, food and numbers 1-15.

**PSHE** will be taught through our Jigsaw scheme of work, looking at the topics; 'Being me in my world' and 'Celebrating difference'.

In **RE**, we will be studying the unit 'Belief in the community'. We will reflect on the question; What does it mean to belong to a faith?

Within **ICT**, we will be looking at drawing and desktop publishing, Internet research and online safety.

We will be learning about **Music** through our scheme of work called Charanga. In Autumn 1, we will be looking at the structure of songs linked to literacy and learning about music and styles of the 70s and 80s. In Autumn 2, we will be learning basic instrumental skills by playing tunes in varying styles using the glockenspiel.

In **PE**, throughout the term, we will be developing our dribbling and passing skills in football with a focus on improving our invasion techniques. We will also be studying gymnastics, dance and rugby. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week. PE for Rhino Class will be on Wednesdays and Thursdays.
