#### Music, School Lunches and Robinwood Payments

Please can we ask that parents monitor their ParentPay accounts to ensure they are not falling into debt with school lunches, trips and music lessons.

<u>Music Lessons:</u> Payment must be made before taking a lesson, this can either be paid termly in one instalment of £50 or £5 weekly.

**School Lunches**: Payment must be made before taking a school lunch, they are charged at a cost of £2.60 unless entitled to free school meals.

**Robinwood:** For those in Year 6 who are attending Robinwood, please ensure the £40 deposit has been paid and the monthly instalment plan is followed.
