## Music, School Lunches and Robinwood Payments

Please can we ask that parents monitor their ParentPay accounts to ensure they are not falling into debt with school lunches, trips and music lessons.

**Music Lessons:** Payment must be made before taking a lesson, this can either be paid termly in one instalment of £50 or £5 weekly.

**School Lunches:** Payment must be made before taking a school lunch, they are charged at a cost of £2.60 unless entitled to free school meals.

**Robinwood:** For those in Year 6 who are attending Robinwood, please ensure the £40 deposit has been paid and the monthly instalment plan is followed.

## Parent Consultations

We are looking forward to holding our first parent consultations of this academic year during the week commencing the 13<sup>th</sup> November. Our intention is that we will hold these meetings face to face after school and the focus of them is on discussing how your child has settled into their new class. There will be chairs placed outside the classrooms for you to use while you wait if the teacher is still seeing another parent. Please can you indicate on the slip below convenient times for you to attend this meeting. We will try wherever possible to put sibling appointments close to each other. We would be grateful if you could return the slip by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October. We will send you confirmation of your appointment date and time by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October by text.
