STREP A

Please be advised that we have had confirmed cases of Strep A.

If you notice your child is unwell and has developed symptoms, please contact the school for advice on exclusion policies and seek medical advice from a GP if needed.

Strep A Symptoms can include:

- flu-like symptoms such as high temperature, swollen glands or an aching body
 - sore throat (Strep Throat or Tonsillitis)
- a rash that feels rough, like sandpaper (Scarlet Fever)
 - scabs and sores (Impetigo)
 - pain and swelling (Cellulitis)
- severe muscle aches • nausea and vomiting
