IPAD: Go to Settings > Screen Time > Turn On Screen Time > Set Screen Time Passcode > Turn On Content Restrictions.

XBOX: Go to Settings > Family Safety > Add Family Member > Select Child > Set Parental Controls.

NINTENDO SWITCH: Go to Settings > Parental Controls > Turn On Parental Controls > Set Parental Controls.

WINDOWS 11 PCs: Go to Settings > Family Safety > Add Family Member > Select Child > Set Parental Controls.

CHROMEBOOKS: Go to Settings > Family Link > Add Family Member > Select Child > Set Parental Controls.

MACS: Go to Settings > Family Safety > Add Family Member > Select Child > Set Parental Controls.
