Dear Parent/Carer,

We are looking forward to holding our second parent consultations of this academic year during the week commencing the 11th March. Our intention is that we will hold these meetings face to face after school and the focus of them is on helping your child to continue to move forwards in their learning.

During the meeting the teacher will share with you information about:

- their strengths
- their areas for development
- how you can help to support your child's learning at home
- your child's wellbeing in school

You will also have the opportunity to ask any questions that you may have.

These appointments will only last for 10 minutes. If you feel that you have many things you wish to discuss with your child's teacher, they will arrange another appointment at a mutually convenient time. We hope you understand that because we need to see all parents we will need to stick closely to the allotted times. There will be chairs placed outside the classrooms for you to use while you wait if the teacher is still seeing another parent. The appointments will take place on Tuesday 12th and Thursday 14th March with the exception of Rhino Class whose appointments will take place on Monday 11th and Tuesday 12th March. We have Trust training on Wednesday 13th March after school so cannot arrange appointments for this evening.

Please can you indicate on the slip below convenient times for you to attend this meeting. We will try wherever possible to put sibling appointments close to each other. We would be grateful if you could return the slip by Monday 26th February. We will send you confirmation of your appointment date and time by Friday 8th March.


