We have had another busy but cold week! On Monday we were very lucky to have a motorbike mechanic visit some of our children – we are incredibly grateful for this opportunity. Some of our teachers had the opportunity for some professional development this week with a visit to Selby Primary which is a Talk 4 Writing school. They have come back full of great ideas of things to do with our pupils. We have also had a Little Wandle advisor visit and she is very pleased with the progress that the children are making with their phonics.

We won't have a Stay and Play during this half term but we will have a whole school one after school on Tuesday 16th July. At this you will be able to visit your child's current class and go to meet their next teacher if they are staying with us next year.
