All swimming lessons will take place in the afternoon between 1:15pm and 2:45pm. Children will be escorted to the Beverley Leisure Centre by members of staff, who will stay with them throughout the swimming experience.

On each day, all children must come to school in normal school uniform and bring a bag containing: suitable swimwear (swimming trunks, shorts, swimming costume), a towel, goggles (if needed), spare socks and underwear (in case lost), a drink and a small healthy snack (no nuts please).

If your child does not pass their swimming by the end of the five weeks they will join the next block of lessons or will do a top up block later in the academic year.
