All swimming lessons will take place in the afternoon between 1:15pm and 2:45pm. Children will be escorted to the Beverley Leisure Centre by members of staff, who will stay with them throughout the swimming experience.

**On each day, all children must come to school in normal school uniform and bring a bag containing: suitable swimwear (swimming trunks, shorts, swimming costume), a towel, goggles (if needed), spare socks and underwear (in case lost), a drink and a small healthy snack (no nuts please).**

If your child does not pass their swimming by the end of the five weeks they will join the next block of lessons or will do a top up block.

## School Meal Charges

The cost of a school meal in effect of September 2024 is now **£2.70**

## Robinwood July 2025

The visit is currently scheduled to place from Friday 4th July until Sunday 6th July 2025 and will cost approximately £350 per pupil (this could be slightly lower depending on numbers attending). This is made up of £285 to pay for the Robinwood stay and approximately £65 for the coach. Should you wish to reserve a place, please complete the consent slip below and return to school by Tuesday 10th September to confirm your child's place. Please note - places will be awarded on a first come, first served basis: a non-refundable deposit of £20 will be required by the end of September.

A letter was sent out this week to express your child's interest please return the letter as soon as possible, ideally before 22<sup>nd</sup> September in order for us to secure an accurate price for the visit.
