If you would like your child to receive their nasal flu vaccination in school, please complete a YES online consent form ASAP. If for any reason your child cannot have the nasal spray vaccine, the injectable flu vaccine is available, and you will be able to choose that method on the consent form. If you **DO NOT** wish your child to receive a flu vaccination, please complete a NO consent via the same link.
